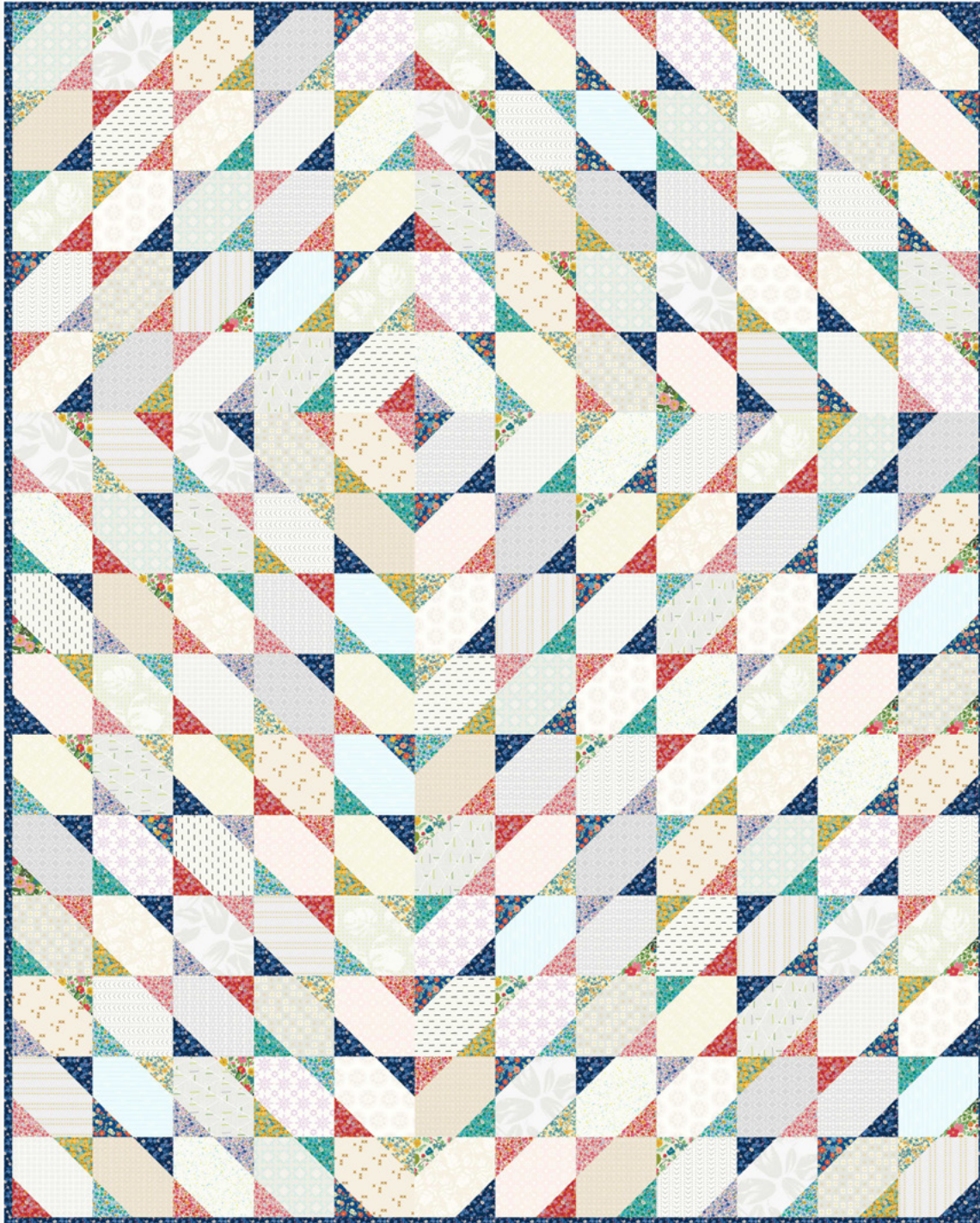

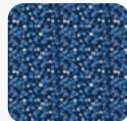

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 68" x 83" (1.73m x 2.11m quilt batting)
- 100% cotton thread
- Basic sewing and pressing supplies

CUTTING

WOF = Width of Fabric

Fabric A, cut:

From each of 12 Fat Quarters cut

(30) 3" squares for a total of (360) 3" squares

Fabric B, cut:

From each of 20 Fat Quarters cut

(9) 5½" squares for a total of (180) 5½" squares

Fabric C, cut:

(8) 2½" x WOF, for binding

SEWING

Note: Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread.

Block Assembly

- 1 Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each **Fabric A** 3" square.
- 2 Arrange 2 randomly selected marked **Fabric A** 3" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric B** 5½" square as shown in **Fig. 1**. Stitch along the marked lines. Trim seam allowances to ¼". Press corners out. Make a total of 180 blocks (5½" square unfinished). **Fig. 2**

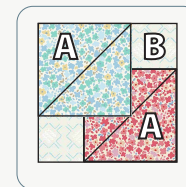
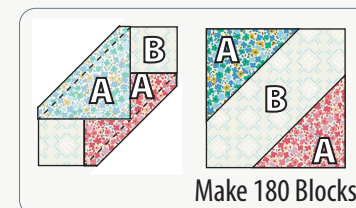

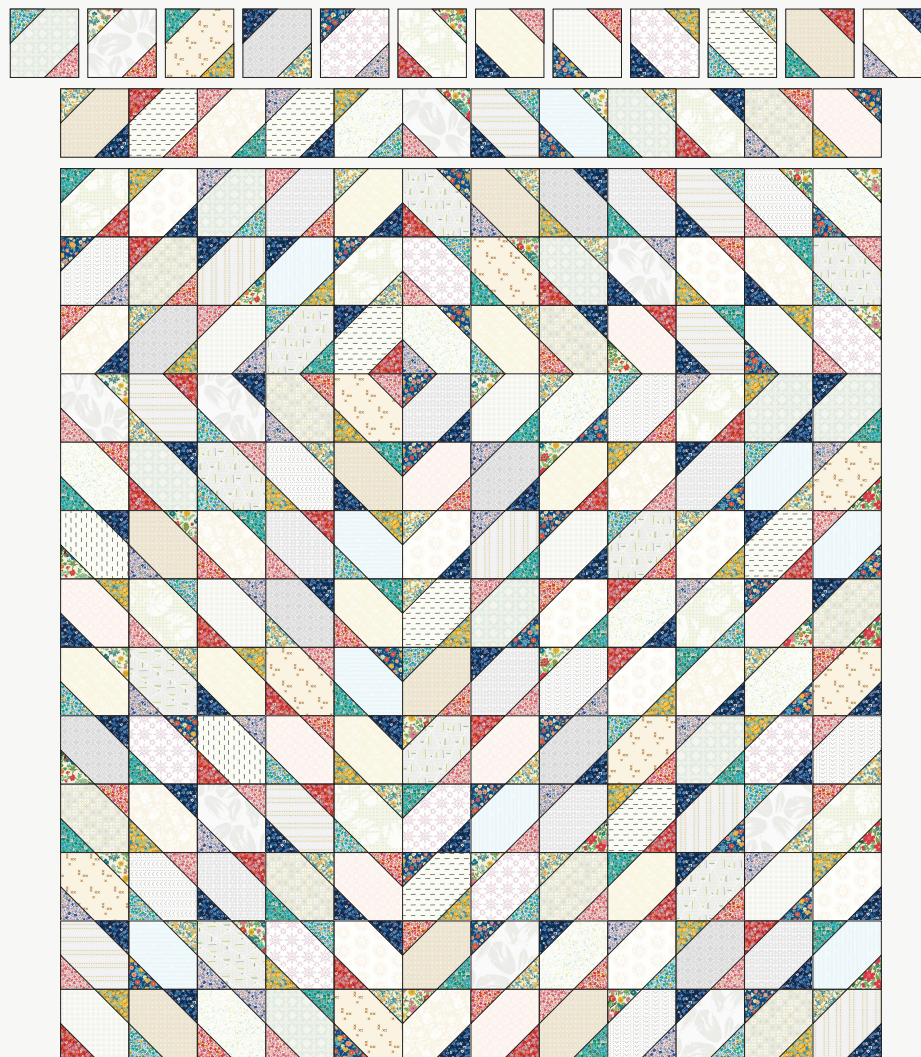
QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

- 3 Noting **Quilt Layout** and rotating the blocks as shown, arrange the blocks in 15 rows of 12. Sew into rows. Sew rows together, carefully matching seams. Press row seams open to reduce bulk. Quilt top measures 60½" x 75½" (unfinished).

FINISHING

- 4 Sew together the (8) 2 ½" **Fabric C** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 5 Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 6 Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.

- 7 Turn the binding to back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
