ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 100% cotton thread
- 71" x 64" (1.80m x 1.63m) batting

CUTTING

WOF = Width of Fabric

From Fabric A, cut:

- (11) $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF; subcut
 - (4) $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $35\frac{3}{4}$ "
 - (8) $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{8}$ "

From Fabric B, fussy cut:

See Fabric B Cutting Diagram on page 4.

- (4) $5\frac{1}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{8}$ ", (2) from each type of skull motif

From Fabric C, fussy cut:

See Fabric C Cutting Diagram on page 4.

- (4) $5\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF, centered horizontally on the ravens; subcut
 - (2) $5\frac{1}{8}$ " x $35\frac{3}{4}$ "
 - (2) $5\frac{1}{8}$ " x $42\frac{3}{4}$ "

Note: If your usable WOF is less than $42\frac{3}{4}$ ", cut an additional $5\frac{1}{8}$ " strip and piece the strips as needed. **Fabric C** yardage allows for this additional strip.

From Fabric D, fussy cut:

- (1) $42\frac{3}{4}$ " wide x $35\frac{3}{4}$ " high rectangle, centered on the coffins

From Fabric E, cut:

- (2) $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF; subcut
 - (7) $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{4}$ ", then cut in half on both diagonals to make (28) triangles - 2 will be extra
- (1) $4\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF; subcut
 - (4) $4\frac{3}{8}$ " x $4\frac{3}{8}$ ", then cut in half on one diagonal into (8) triangles

From Fabric F, cut:

- (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding

From Fabric G, cut:

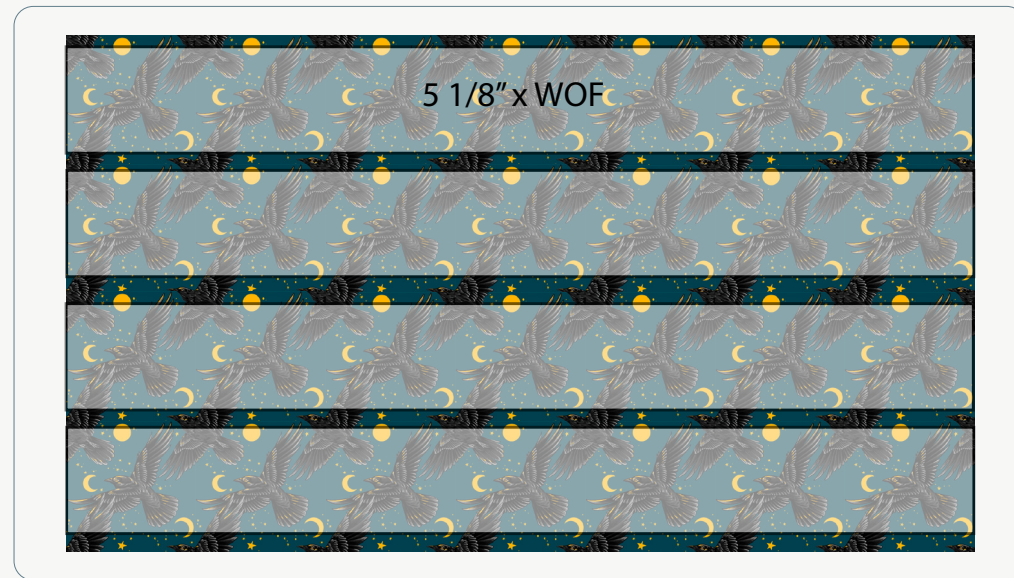
- (2) $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF; subcut
 - (8) $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{4}$ ", then cut in half on both diagonals to make (32) triangles - 2 will be extra
- (1) 4" x WOF; subcut
 - (4) 4" x 4"

Fabric C Cutting Diagram

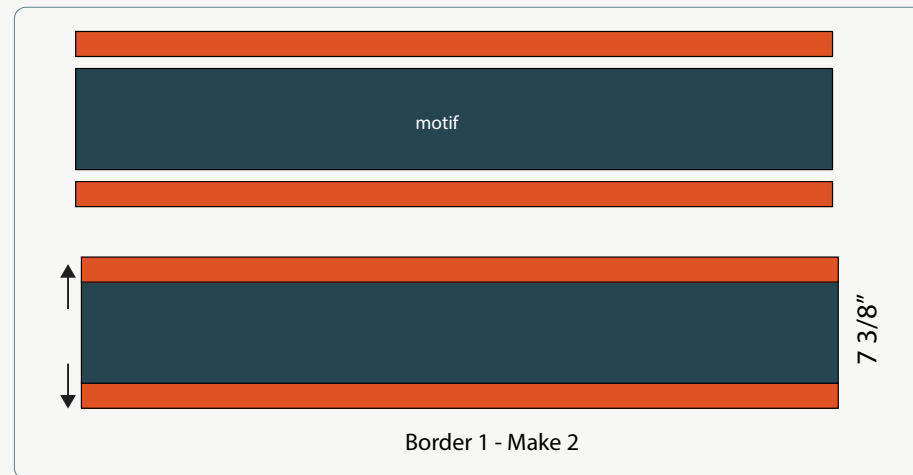


INSTRUCTIONS

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press after each seam in the direction of the arrows.

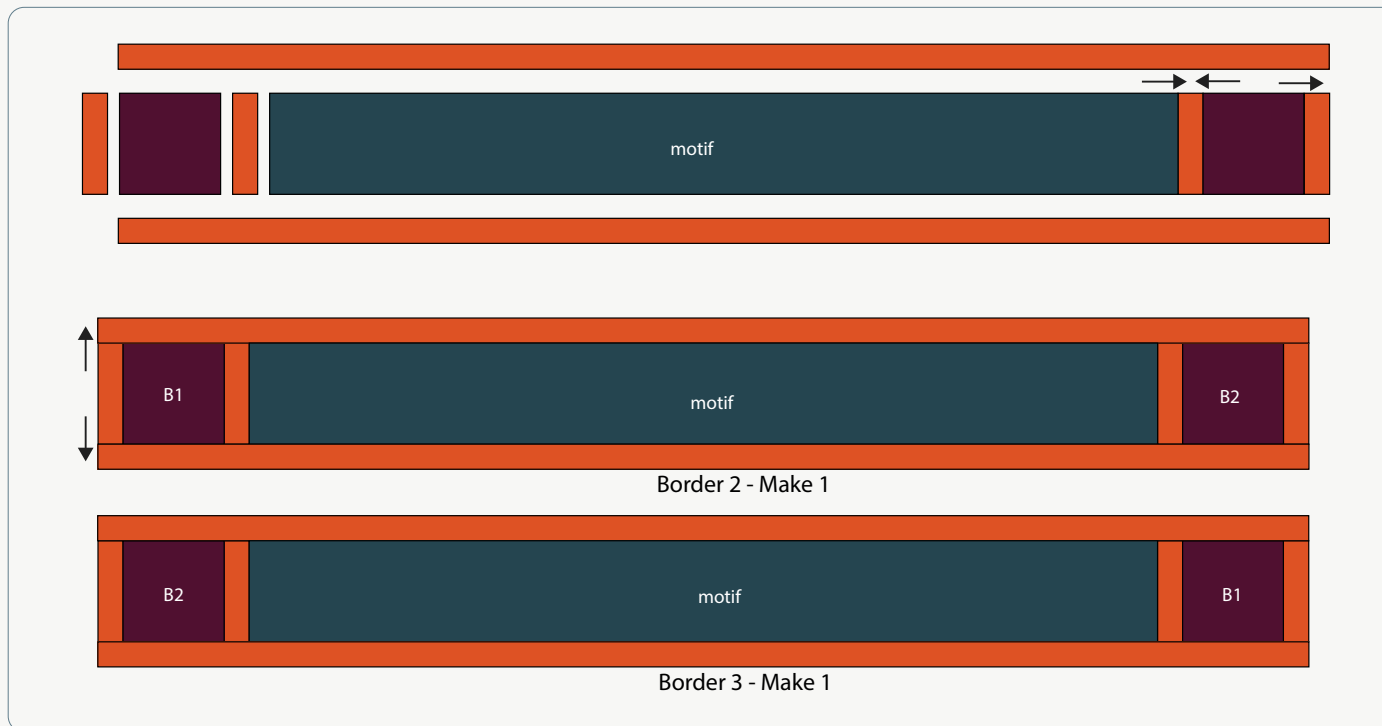
- 1 Sew a **Fabric A** $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $35\frac{3}{4}$ " strip to the top and bottom of a **Fabric C** $5\frac{1}{8}$ " x $35\frac{3}{4}$ " strip, noting orientation of the raven motifs, to make Border 1. Make (2).

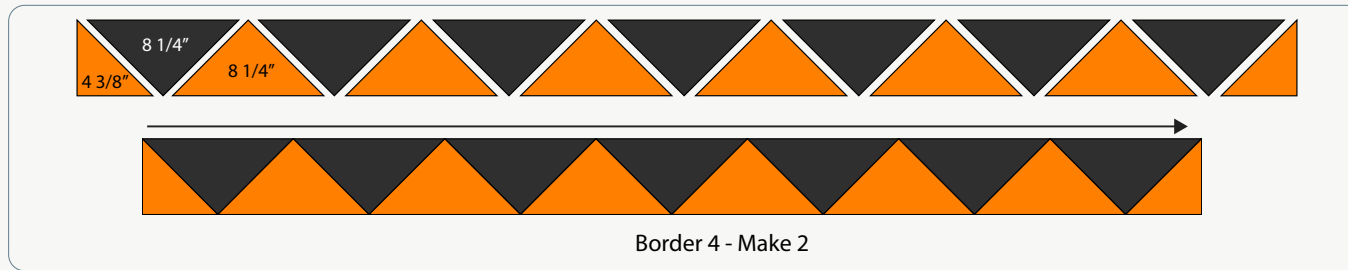
- 2 Arrange (1) of each **Fabric B** fussy-cut square, (4) **Fabric A** $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{8}$ " strips, and (1) **Fabric C** $5\frac{1}{8}$ " x $42\frac{3}{4}$ " strip, in a row as shown, making sure all fussy-cut motifs are oriented right reading. Sew together. Using the remaining **Fabric A** $1\frac{5}{8}$ " strip lengths, including usable leftover lengths from the previous subcuts, sew pieces together end to end as needed and cut (4) $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew a **Fabric A** $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and bottom to make Border 2. Repeat, switching the position of the **Fabric B** motifs, to make Border 3.

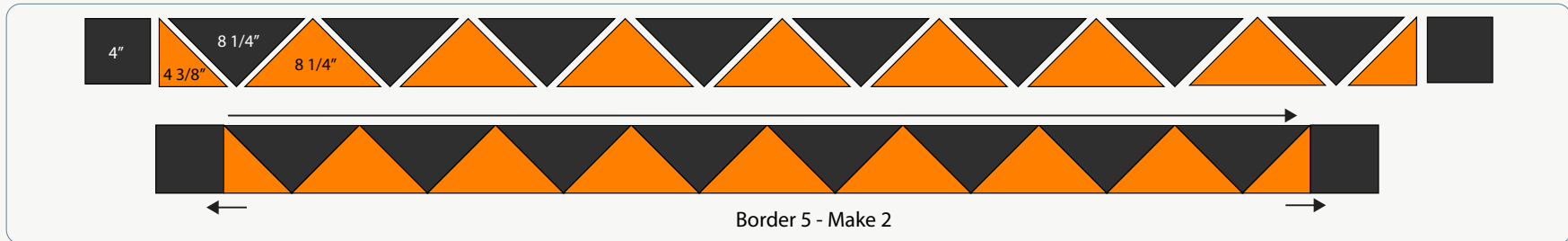
- 3** Arrange (2) **Fabric E** $4\frac{3}{8}$ " triangles, (7) **Fabric G** triangles, and (6) **Fabric E** $8\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles together in a row as shown. Sew together, making sure to offset the triangles so the long sides of the row will be straight, to make Border 4 ($49\frac{1}{2}$ " long). Make (2).

- 4** Arrange (2) **Fabric G** squares, (2) **Fabric E** $4\frac{3}{8}$ " triangles, (8) **Fabric G** triangles and (7) **Fabric E** $8\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles, together in a row as shown. Sew together to make Border 5 ($63\frac{1}{2}$ " long). Make (2).

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Note: Follow the **Quilt Layout** diagram (page 9) while assembling the quilt.

- 5 Pin, matching ends and centers, then sew a Border 1 to the left and right sides of the **Fabric D** 42 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 35 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle, noting orientation of the raven motifs in the borders. Press towards the border.
- 6 Repeat Step 5 to add Border 2 to the top and Border 3 to the bottom of the quilt center.
- 7 Repeat Step 5 to add Border 4 to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press towards the inner border. Note: if the borders' length is slightly off from the size of the quilt center, pin whichever piece is longer on the bottom. Sew with the longer piece towards the feed dogs – they will help ease in the extra length.
- 8 Repeat step 7 to add Border 5 to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt.

FINISHING

- 9 Sew together the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric F** binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 10 Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 11 Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- 12 Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
