## Additional Requirements

- Coats Dual Duty XP ${ }^{\circledR}$ All-purpose thread
- Coats Machine Quilting or Hand Quilting Thread in color(s) to match fabrics
- 80 " $\times 94^{\prime \prime}(203.20 \mathrm{~cm} \times 238.76 \mathrm{~cm})$ batting
- Rotary cutter/mat/ruler
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing and pressing supplies
- Spray starch or starch alternative


## Cutting

Note: Use spray starch or starch alternative on Fabrics A-X before cutting, to help stabilize bias edges of the halfsquare triangles (HST).

## WOF = Width of Fabric; HST = Half-square Triangle

Fabrics A, C, F, G, H, and I, cut from each:
(2) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (6) $8^{\prime \prime}(20.32 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (12) HST

## Fabric B, cut:

(2) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (10) $8^{\prime \prime}(20.32 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (20) HST

## Fabric D, cut:

(2) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (7) $8^{\prime \prime}(20.32 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (14) HST

## Fabric E, cut:

(2) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (9) $8^{\prime \prime}(20.32 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (18) HST

Fabrics J, O, and R, cut from each:
(1) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (2) $8^{\prime \prime}(20.32 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (4) HST

Fabrics K, N, P, S, T, U, V, and W, cut from each:
(1) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (5) $8^{\prime \prime}$ ( 20.32 cm ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (10) HST

Fabrics $L$ and $X$, cut from each:
(1) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (4) $8^{\prime \prime}(20.32 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (8) HST

Fabric M, cut:
(1) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (1) $8^{\prime \prime}$ ( 20.32 cm ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (2) HST

Fabric Q, cut:
(1) $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $20.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (3) $8^{\prime \prime}$ ( 20.32 cm ) squares, cut once diagonally to make (6) HST

## Fabric $\mathbf{Y}$, cut:

Enough $2112^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ bias strips to make $330^{\prime \prime}(8.38 \mathrm{~m})$ finished binding

## Sewing

All seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Sew together (1) Fabric K and (1) Fabric J HST along the diagonal edges to make (1) block (Fig. 1). Press the seam allowances toward the darker fabric. The block should measure $75 / 8^{\prime \prime}(19.37 \mathrm{~cm})$ square; trim if needed. Make a total of (120) blocks in the fabric combinations and quantities listed below:

## Quilt Top Assembly

2. Following the Quilt Layout for block placement and orientation, lay out the blocks in (12) rows of (10) blocks each. Sew together the blocks in each row. Press the seams in alternate directions for adjacent rows. The finished rows should each measure $75 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ $713 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ( $19.37 \mathrm{~cm} \times 182.25 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
3. Sew the rows together in order and press the seam allowances in one direction.

## Finishing

4. Sew together the $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $\mathbf{Y}$ binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
5. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
6. Leaving an $8^{\prime \prime}(20.32 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" $(30.48 \mathrm{~cm})$ from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
7. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
