## Preparation

Trace Piece 1 onto template plastic and cut out. Mark the grain line.

## Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric
QST = Quarter-square Triangle
HST = Half-square Triangle
Fabrics A-T, cut from each:
(1) $4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ square
(4) $2^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares
(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$
(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 / 4 " ~}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 15.88 \mathrm{~cm})$
(4) Piece 1

## Fabrics U-NN, cut from each:

(1) $5^{1} 1^{\prime \prime}(13.34 \mathrm{~cm})$ square, cut twice diagonally to make (4) OST
(8) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}(7.30 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares, cut once diagonally to make (16) HST

## Fabric OO, cut:

(6) $2^{1} 12^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF), for binding

## Sewing

All seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and pieces are sewn right sides together. Note that some prints are directional, so pay attention to the finished block orientation within the quilt when piecing.

Be careful in piecing the Mother's Favorite quilt blocks - an accurate $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ seam allowance is very important.

1. Sew matching $51^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}}(13.34 \mathrm{~cm})$ QST to opposite sides of a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ square (Fig. 1). Press seams toward the triangles. Stitch the remaining matching
$5^{11 / 4^{\prime \prime}}(13.34 \mathrm{~cm})$ OST to the remaining sides to make a pieced square. Press seams toward the triangles. Make (1) pieced square in each of the following fabric combinations: A/U, B/V, C/W, D/X, E/Y, F/Z, G/AA, H/BB, I/CC, J/DD, K/EE, L/FF, M/GG, N/HH, O/II, P/JJ, Q/KK, R/LL, S/MM, and T/NN.

2. Sew matching $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 15.88 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips to opposite sides of pieced square (Fig. 2). Press seams toward the strips. Stitch matching $2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ 22.86 cm ) strips to the remaining sides of the pieced square to make a center unit. Press seams toward the strips. The unit should measure 9" $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ square.

3. Following Figure 3, sew (2) rows using (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ square and a matching Piece 1, and (4) matching $2{ }^{1 / 8^{\prime \prime}}(7.30 \mathrm{~cm})$ HST. Press seams toward the triangles. Sew the rows together to make a pieced triangle. Press seam toward Piece 1. Make (4) per block.

4. Following Figure 4, sew the pieced triangles to opposite sides of the center unit. Press seams toward center. Sew the remaining pieced triangles to the remaining sides to make Mother's Favorite Block, which should measure $12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}(31.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ square. Press seams toward the center. Repeat Steps 2 through 4 to make a total of (20) assorted blocks.

## Quilt Top Assembly

5. Referring to the Quilt Layout diagram, lay out the quilt top in (5) rows of (4) blocks each. Sew the blocks together in each row. Press seams in alternate directions for adjacent rows. Sew the rows together in order. Press the seams in one direction.

## Finishing

6. Sew together the $2^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $\mathbf{O O}$ binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
7. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim the excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
8. Leaving an $8^{\prime \prime}(20.22 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately $12^{\prime \prime}$ $(30.48 \mathrm{~cm})$ from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
9. Turn the binding to the back of the quilt and handstitch in place.
