- 76 " $\times 80$ " ( $1.93 \mathrm{~m} \times 2.03 \mathrm{~m}$ ) batting
- Template plastic


## Heart Beats Quilt

## Prep

Print the template patterns on page 6 at $100 \%$ actual size. Trace onto template plastic, transfer all markings, and cut out on the outer solid line.

## Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric
Note: Alternate triangles $180^{\circ}$ while cutting (Fig.1).

To cut reversed half-triangles, flip the template over to cut with the text side down. Label cut pieces with fabric letter identifier for easier construction. Depending on how efficiently triangles are cut from Fabrics $\mathbf{A}$ and B, 1 additional WOF strip may be needed, and has been allowed for in the yardage listed on page 2.

## Fabrics $A$ and $B$, cut from each:

(7) $6^{1 / 2 " 1} \times$ WOF; sub-cut
(99) triangles
(3) half-triangles
(3) reversed half-triangles

Fabrics C-AC, cut from each:
(1) $6^{11 / 2 "} \times$ WOF; sub-cut
(6) triangles

## Fabrics AD and AE, cut from each:

(1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF; sub-cut
(5) triangles and
(1) half-triangle

## Fabrics AF and AG, cut from each:

(1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF; sub-cut
(5) triangles and
(1) reversed half-triangle

## Fabrics AH, AI, AJ, and AK, cut from each:

(1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF; sub-cut
(4) triangles
(1) half-triangle
(1) reversed half-triangle

## Fabric AL, bias-cut:

Enough $2 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$-wide bias strips to make 300 " of bias binding

## Instructions

Note: All seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted. Sew pieces right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

1. Referring to Row 1 in the Quilt Layout diagram (page 5) for fabric placement, arrange (16) Fabric B triangles, (3) each Fabrics AE, C, Q, J, and $\mathbf{S}$ triangles, (2) Fabric AF triangles, and (1) half-triangle and (1) reversed Fabric $\mathbf{B}$ half-triangles in a single horizontal row. Sew the triangles and half-triangles together along adjacent edges. Press.
2. Refer to the Quilt Layout diagram (page 5) to arrange triangles and half-triangles for each additional row. Sew the triangles and half-triangles in each row together along adjacent edges. Press.
3. Sew the rows together along adjacent edges, noting that the upper points of the triangles in each row align vertically with the upper points of the triangles in the row below it. Press the seam allowances in one direction.

## Finishing

4. Sew the bias-cut $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric AL binding strips together end-to-end. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
5. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top after quilting is completed.
6. Leaving an 8 " tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12 " from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 44^{4}$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
7. Turn the binding to the back of the quilt and hand stitch in place.
