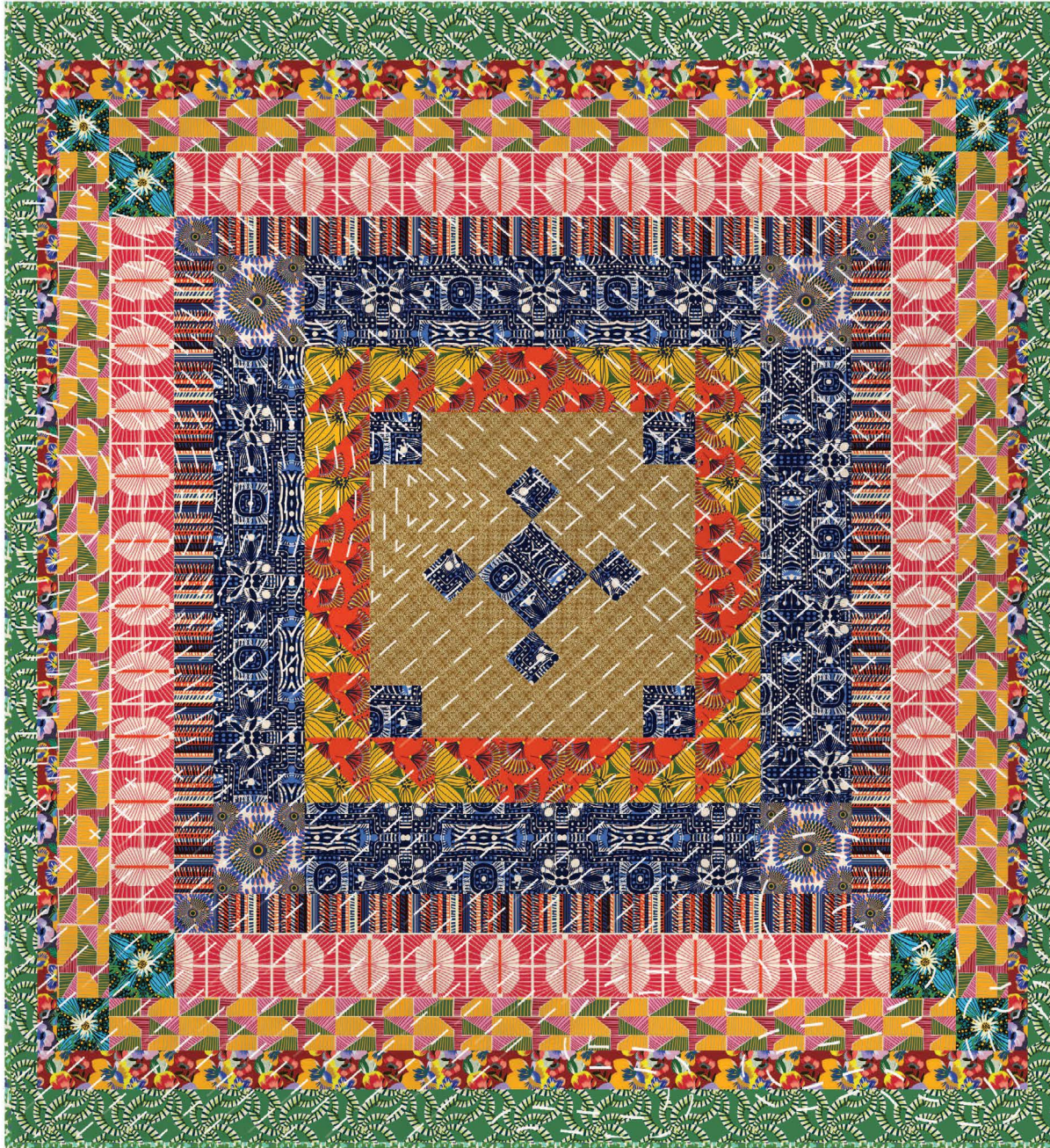

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Tech edited by: Alison M. Schmidt)

* For best results, we recommend **NOT** prewashing fabrics. Laundering may alter the dimensions required to complete the project as designed.

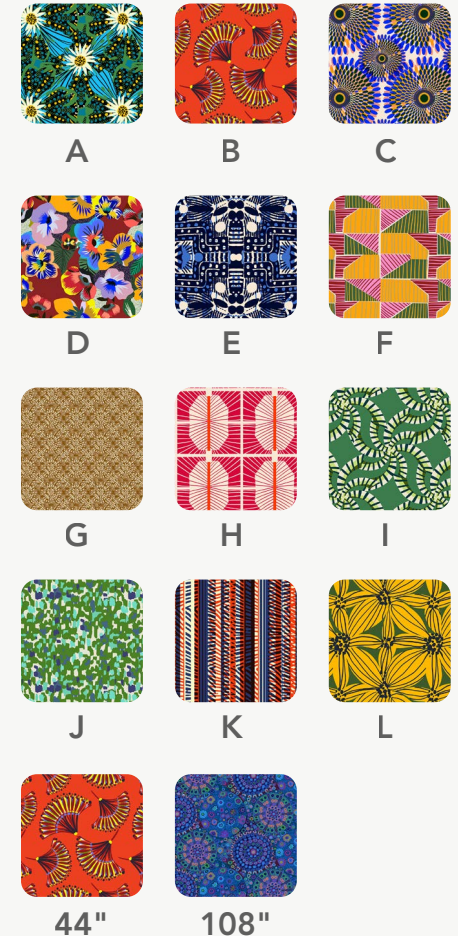

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 100% cotton thread
- 88" x 95" (2.24m x 2.41m)
- Thread for kantha-style hand quilting, if desired. Look up Kantha stitching on your favorite hand stitching website.

CUTTING

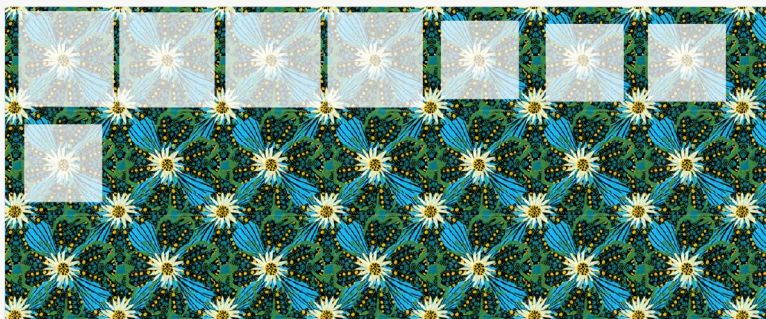
WOF = Width of Fabric

Note: Full WOF strips are reserved for borders; they will be sewn together and cut to the size needed for each round as it is to be added.

Fabric A, fussy cut, centered on the white flowers:

- (4) 5½" squares
- (4) 4½" squares

Fabric A Fussy Cutting diagram



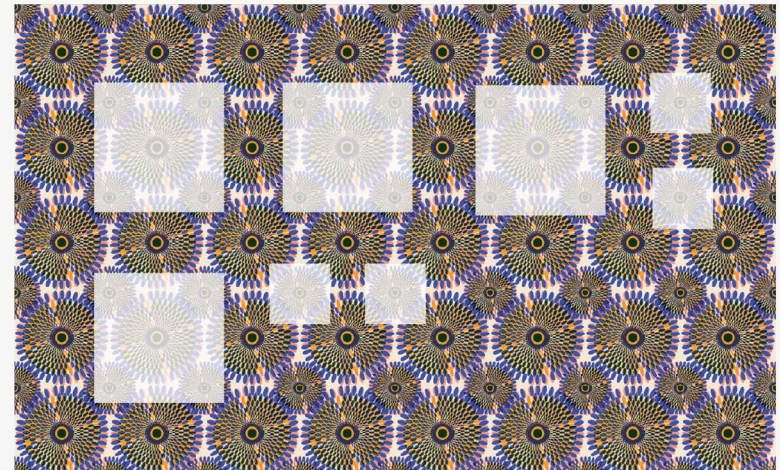
Fabric B, cut:

- (2) 6" x WOF; subcut
(10) 6" squares
- (1) 5½" x WOF; subcut
(4) 5½" squares

Fabric C, fussy cut:

- (4) 7½" squares, centered on the larger gold rings
- (4) 3½" squares, centered on the smaller gold rings

Fabric D, cut:

- (4) 3½" x WOF for Top/Bottom Border #5
- (4) 2" x WOF for Side Border #5

Fabric E, cut:

- (4) 7½" x WOF; subcut
 - (4) 7½" x 35½" for Border #1
- (1) 6½" x WOF; subcut
 - (1) 6½" square
 - (4) 4½" squares
 - (4) 3½" squares

Fabric F, cut:

- (7**) 4½" x WOF for Border #4
- **Cut 1 more WOF strip if planning to join border strips with diagonal seams.*

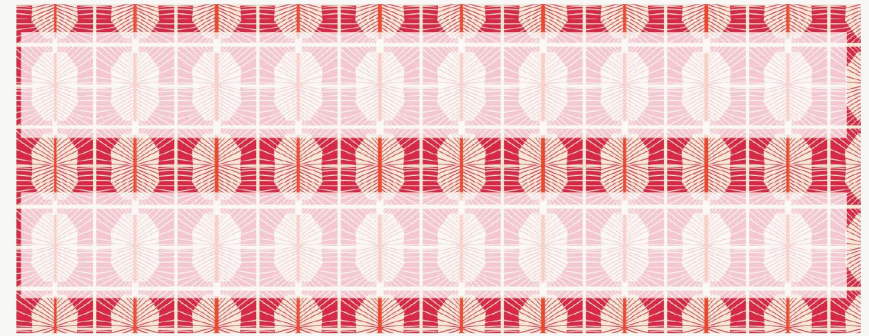
Fabric G, cut:

- (1) 9¾" x WOF; subcut
 - (2) 9¾" squares, then cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles
 - (4) 3½" x 6½"
- (2) 4½" x WOF; subcut
 - (4) 4½" x 17½"

Fabric H, fussy cut:

- (6) 5½" x WOF, centered on the lozenge shapes, for Border #3

Note: only 2 of the 6 strips needed are shown, fussy cut all the same.

Fabric I, cut:

- (5*) 4½" x WOF for Top/Bottom Border #6
- (5*) 2½" x WOF Side Border #6
- *You may need 1 less WOF strip if planning to join border strips with straight seams.*

Fabric J, cut:

- (10) 2½" x WOF, for binding

Fabric K, cut:

(6*) 3½" x WOF for Border #2

**You may need 1 less WOF strip if planning to join border strips with straight seams.*

Fabric L, cut:

(2) 6" x WOF; subcut

(10) 6" squares

INSTRUCTIONS

Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread.

Block Construction

- 1 Arrange 1 **Fabric E** 6½" square, 4 **Fabric E** 3½" squares, and 4 **Fabric G** 3½" x 6½" pieces in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Unit 1 (12½" square unfinished) (**Fig. 1**).

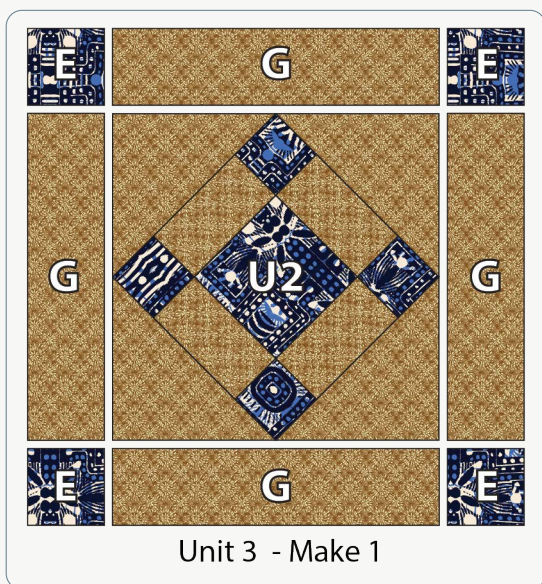
- 2 Stitch a **Fabric G** 9⅞" half-square triangles to each of the 4 sides of Unit 1 to complete Unit 2 (17½" square unfinished) (**Fig. 2**).

- 3** Arrange Unit 2, 4 **Fabric E** $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and 4 **Fabric G** $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $17\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Unit 3 ($25\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished) (**Fig. 3**).

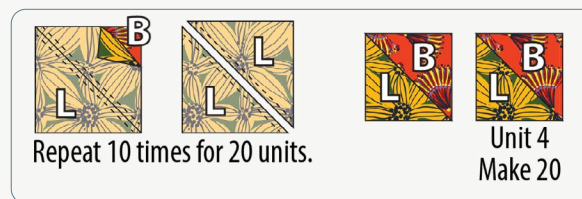
- 4** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each **Fabric L** 6" square. Draw a line $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the first line) (**Fig. 4**).

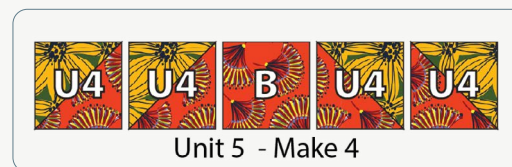
- 5** Arrange 1 marked **Fabric L** 6" square right sides together with a **Fabric B** 6" square, aligning all raw edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut on the center line. Press each half-square triangle open (**Fig. 5**). Centering the seam, trim each unit to $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square (unfinished). Make a total of 20 Unit 4.

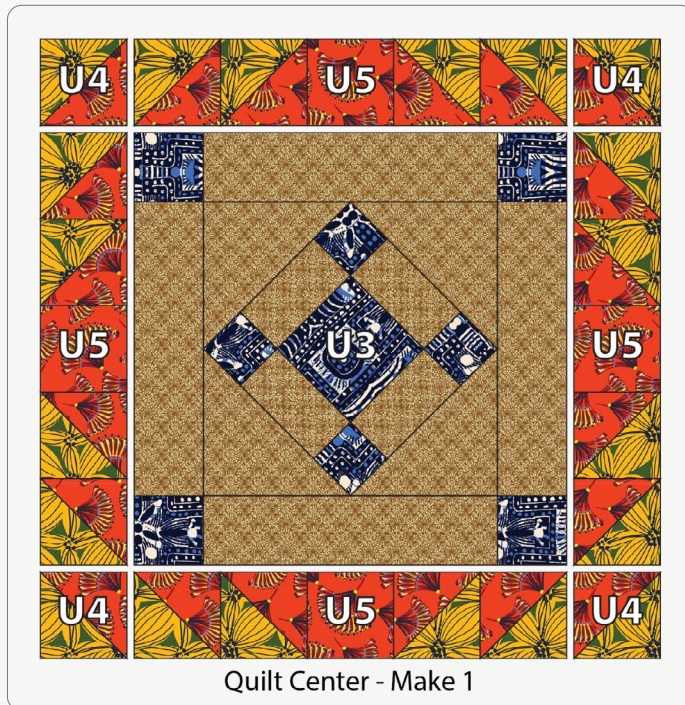
- 6** Arrange 4 Unit 4 and 1 **Fabric B** $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square in a row as shown. Stitch together. Make a total of 4 Unit 5 ($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished) (**Fig. 6**).

- 7** Arrange Unit 3, 4 Unit 4, and 4 Unit 5 in 3 rows as shown (**Fig. 7**). Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete the Quilt Center (35½" square unfinished).

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

- 8** Noting the **Quilt Layout** diagram (page 9), arrange the Quilt Center, 4 fussy-cut **Fabric C** 7½" squares, and 4 **Fabric E** 7½" x 35½" Border #1 strips in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together.
- 9** Trim the selvages off all the **Fabric D** WOF strips. Sew all the **Fabric D** 2" x WOF strips together end to end into 1 continuous strip and press the seam allowances open. Repeat with the **Fabric D** 3½" x WOF strips, and all the other WOF strips of **Fabrics F, H, I, and K**. Set the continuous border strips aside; each round of fabric will be individually trimmed to size and then added.
- 10** Measure the quilt top horizontally and vertically through the middle; it should measure 49½" square. Cut the joined **Fabric K** strip into (4) 49½"-long Border #2 strips.

Stitch Border #2 to the right and left sides of the quilt top, pinning and matching ends and centers. Sew fussy-cut **Fabric C** 3½" squares to both ends of the 2 remaining **Fabric K** Border #2 strips, then add to the top and bottom of quilt.

- 11** Repeat the previous step to make and add (4) each 55½"-long fussy-cut **Fabric H** Border #3 strips and fussy-cut **Fabric A** 5½" squares, and then (4) each 65½"-long **Fabric F** Border #4 strips and fussy-cut **Fabric A** 4½" squares.
- 12** Measure the quilt top horizontally and vertically through the middle; it should measure 73½" square. Cut the **Fabric D** 2" x WOF continuous strip into (2) 73½"-long Side Border #5 strips. Sew to the right and left sides of the quilt top. Cut the **Fabric D** 3½" x WOF continuous strip into (2) 76½"-long Top/Bottom Border #5 strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 13** Repeat the previous step to make and add (2) **Fabric I** 2½" x 79½" Side Border #6 strips to the sides, and then (2) **Fabric I** 4½" x 80½" Top/Bottom Border #6 strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.
- 15** Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and hand quilt using kantha-style running stitches, machine quilt, or tie as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 16** Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the front of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- 17** Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.

FINISHING

- 14** Sew together the 2½" **Fabric J** binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
