## CUTTING

**WOF = Width of Fabric**

**HST= Half-square Triangle**

**QST = Quarter-square Triangle**

**Fabrics A, C, D, G, and K, cut from each:**

- (1) 5" x WOF; subcut
- (3) 9½" x 5"

**Fabrics B, H, I, J, and L, cut from each:**

- (1) 5" x WOF; subcut
- (2) 9½" x 5"

**Fabric E, cut:**

- (1) 4¾" x WOF; subcut
- (4) 4¾" x 4¾", then cut in half diagonally twice into 16 QSTs
- (2) 3" x WOF; subcut
- (24) 3" x 3"
- (16) 1½" x WOF for strip sets

**Fabric F, cut:**

- (2) 14" x WOF; subcut
- (3) 14" x 14", then cut in half diagonally twice into 12 QSTs
- (2) 7¼" x 7¼", then cut in half diagonally once into 4 HSTs
- (7) 2½" x WOF for binding

**Fabric M, cut:**

- (7) 1¼" x WOF; subcut
- (25) 9½" x 1¼"

**Fabric N, cut:**

- (3) 2" x WOF; subcut
- (25) 4¼" x 2"

**Fabric O, cut:**

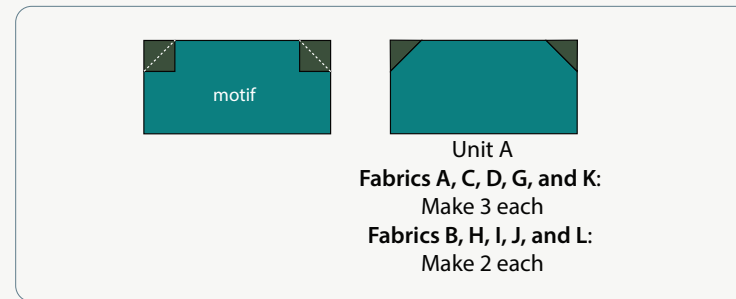
- (6) 4¼" x WOF; subcut
- (50) 4¼" x 4¼"
- (3) 2" x WOF; subcut
- (50) 2" x 2"
- (2) 1¼" x WOF; subcut
- (50) 1¼" x 1¼"
- (32) 1¼" x WOF for strip sets

## INSTRUCTIONS

Use a ¼" seam allowance. Press after each seam.

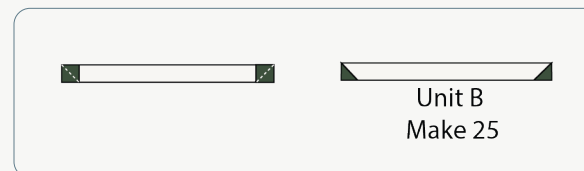
- 1 Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each **Fabric O** 2" x 2" and 1¼" x 1¼" square.
- 2 Pin a marked **Fabric O** 2" x 2" square to both top corners of a **Fabric A** 9½" x 5" rectangle as shown (**Fig. 1**). Sew along the line, trim the seam allowances to ¼", and press towards **Fabric O** to make a Unit A. Make (3) each with **Fabrics A, C, D, G, and K**, making sure any fabric pieces with directional motifs are right-reading. Make (2) each with **Fabrics B, H, I, J, and L**, again making sure any fabric pieces with directional motifs are right-reading.

- 3 Pin a marked **Fabric O** 1¼" x 1¼" square on each end of a **Fabric M** 9½" x 1¼" strip as shown (**Fig. 2**). Sew along the line, trim the seam allowances to ¼", and press towards **Fabric O** to make Unit B. Make (25).

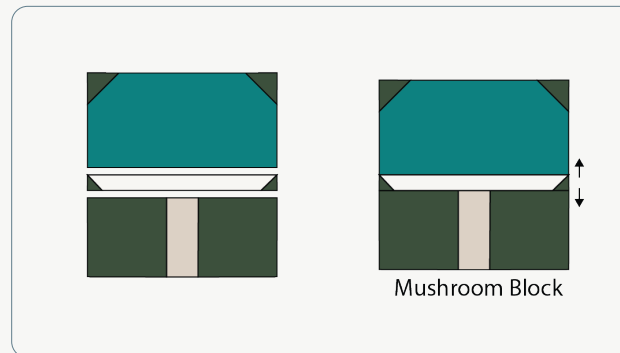
- 4 Sew **Fabric O** 4¼" x 4¼" squares to opposite sides of a **Fabric N** 2" x 4¼" strip as shown (**Fig. 3**) to make Unit C. Press towards **Fabric N**. Make (25).

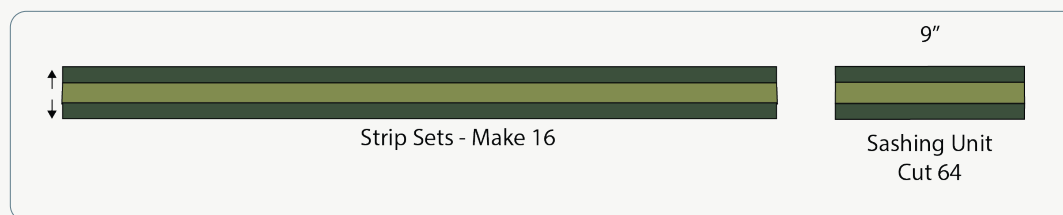
- 5 Sew (1) each of Units A, B, and C together to make a Mushroom Block. Press away from Unit B. Make (25) blocks total.

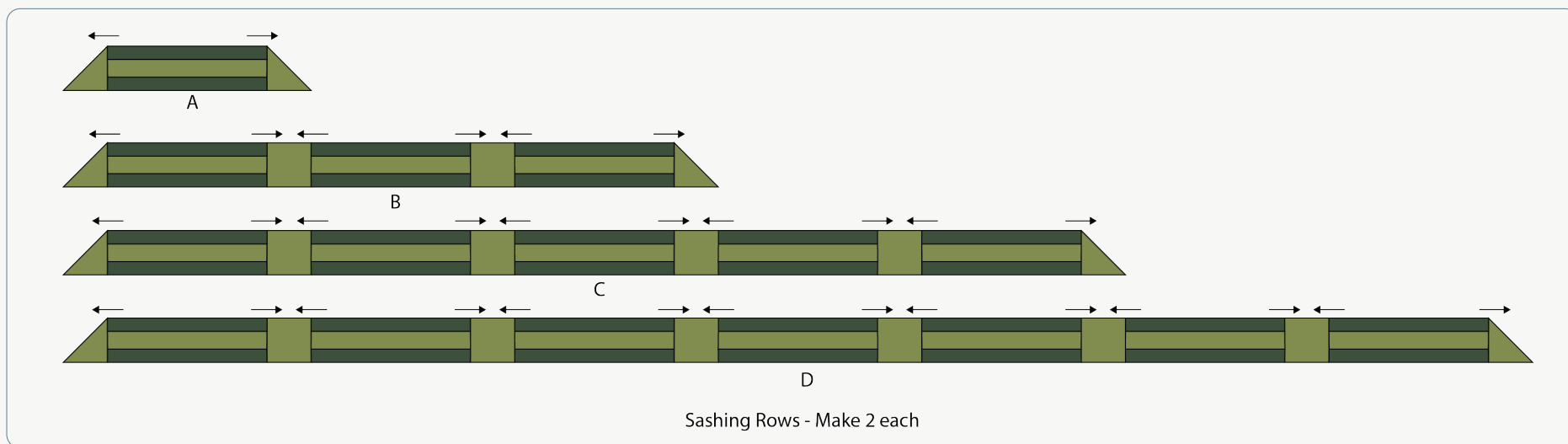
- 6 Sew (1) **Fabric E** 1½" x WOF strip between (2) **Fabric O** 1¼" x WOF strips to make a strip set measuring 3" tall, including seam allowances. Make (16) strip sets. From the strip sets, cut (64) 9½"-long Sashing Units. Set (32) aside for the Block Rows.

- 7 Sew the remaining Sashing Units together with the **Fabric E** 3" x 3" squares and 4¾" QSTs to make the Sashing Rows A-D shown below. Make (2) each.

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Refer to the **Quilt Layout Diagram** (page 8) for block placement and orientation.

- 8** Arrange the Mushroom Blocks, reserved Sashing Units, and **Fabric F** side and corner setting triangles together into (7) diagonal rows, rotating every other block as shown.
- 9** Sew into Block Rows, pressing seam allowances towards the Blocks.
- 10** Arrange the Block Rows and Sashing Rows A-D as shown in the quilt layout diagram, then sew together. Add the (2) remaining **Fabric F** corner setting triangles to complete the quilt top.

## FINISHING

- 11** Sew together the 2½" **Fabric F** binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 12** Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 13** Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- 14** Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
