10" x 10" (25.40cm x 25.40cm)

CUTTING

WOF = Width of Fabric

HST = Half-square Triangle

QST = Quarter-square Triangle

Note: Cut from largest to smallest, using leftovers for smaller pieces, for most efficient use of fabric.

Fabrics A, B, C, D, F, G, H, J, K, and L, cut from each:

(1) 7½" x WOF; subcut

(3) 7½" x 7½"

Fabric E, cut:

(23) 3" x WOF; subcut

(4) 3" x 12"

(18) 3" x 11"

(40) 3" x 10½"

(18) 3" x 8½"

(40) 3" x 5½"

(9) 2½" x WOF for binding

Fabric I, cut:

(2) 8⅛" x WOF; subcut

(5) 8⅛" x 8⅛", then cut in half diagonally twice to make (20) QSTs

(2) 4⅜" x 4⅜", then cut in half diagonally once to make (4) HSTs

(3) 5½" x WOF; subcut

(20) 5½" x 5½"

Fabric M, cut:

(10) 6" x WOF; subcut

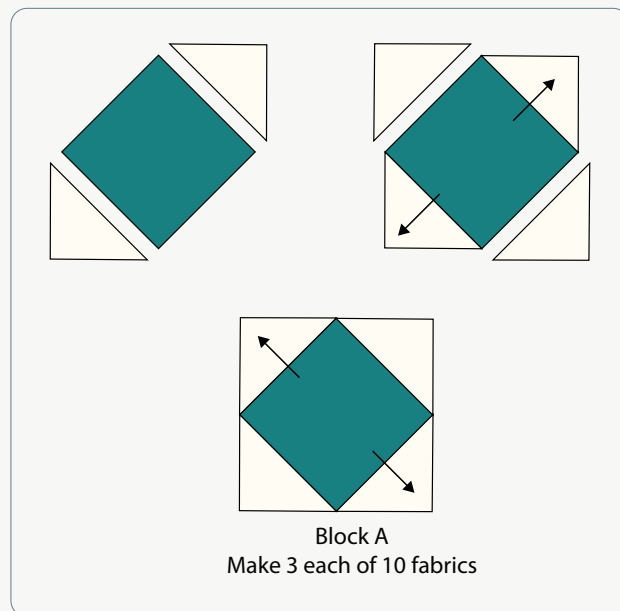
(60) 6" x 6", then cut in half diagonally once to make (120) HSTs

INSTRUCTIONS

Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press after each seam following the arrows in the diagrams.

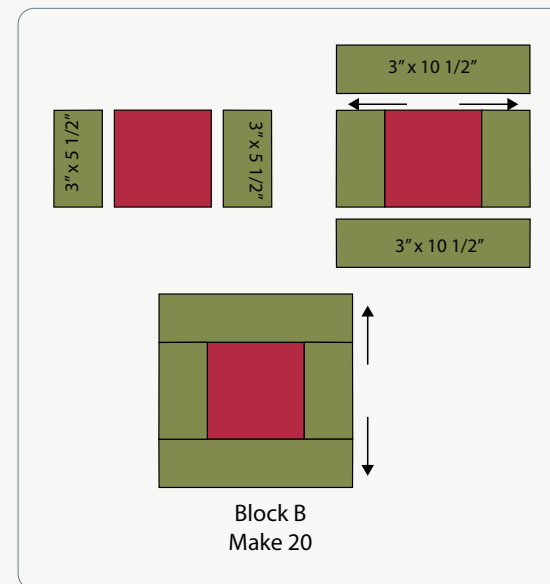
- 1 Sew a pair of **Fabric M** 6" HSTs to opposite sides of a **Fabric A** $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown (**Fig. 1**). Press, then sew a second pair of HSTs to the remaining sides. Press. If needed, trim and square to $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " to complete Block A. Make (3) each with **Fabrics A, B, C, D, F, G, H, J, K, and L**.

- 2 Sew a pair of **Fabric E** 3" x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to opposite sides of a **Fabric I** $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Press, then sew a pair of **Fabric E** 3" x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom to complete Block B. Press. Make (20).

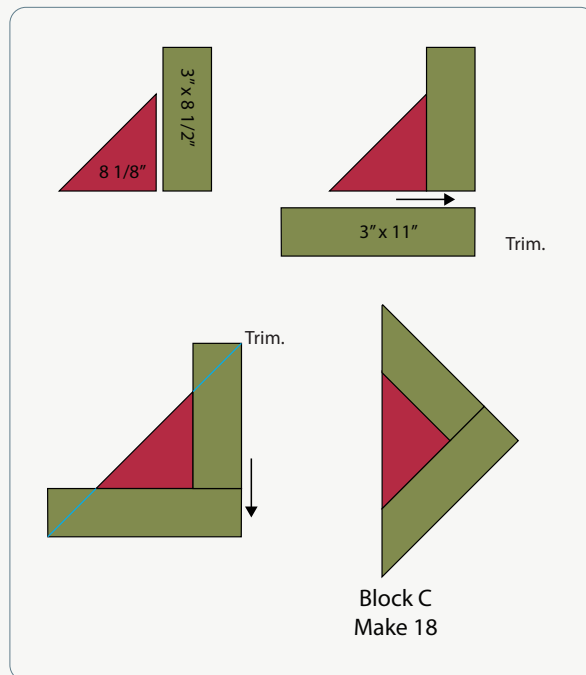

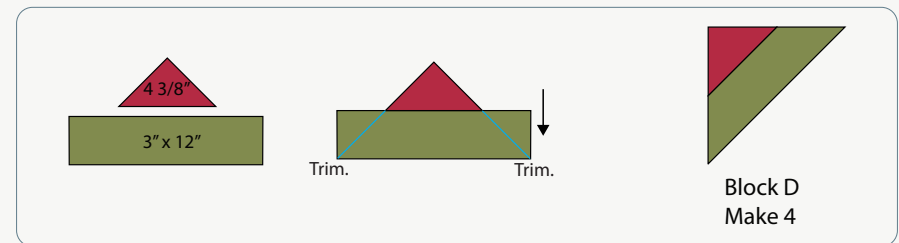
- 3** Sew a **Fabric E** 3" x 8½" strip to one short side of a **Fabric I** 8½" QST as shown (**Fig. 3**). Press, then sew a **Fabric E** 3" x 11" strip to the adjacent side as shown. Press, then trim the ends even with the raw edge of the **Fabric I** QST to complete Block C. Make (18).

- 4** Fold the **Fabric I** 4¾" HSTs and **Fabric E** 3" x 12" strips in half and crease to mark the centers. Sew (1) of each together, matching the centers. Press, then trim the ends even with the raw edge of the **Fabric I** HST to complete Block D. Make (4).

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Refer to the **Quilt Layout** Diagram (page 6) for block placement and orientation.

- 5** Referring to the layout diagram and the image on page 1 if you wish to arrange Block A with the center fabric squares in the same positions as the cover quilt, arrange the A, B, C, and D Blocks together as shown into diagonal rows.
- 6** Sew the block into rows, pressing away from the A Blocks.
- 7** Sew the rows together, adding the remaining (2) D Blocks at the upper left and lower right corners to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING

- 8 Sew together the 2½" **Fabric E** binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 9 Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 10 Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- 11 Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
