Stars twinkle at night through the flowered  
branches in a lush garden.

8" x 8" (20.32cm x 20.32cm)

## CUTTING

**WOF = Width of Fabric**

**Fabrics A-C and G-I, cut from each:**

- (1) 4½" x WOF; subcut
  - (5) 4½" squares
- (3) 2½" x WOF; subcut
  - (40) 2½" squares

**Fabric D, cut:**

- (2) 12<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x WOF; subcut
  - (5) 12<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares, then cut each in half diagonally twice for side setting triangles (2 will be extra)
- (1) 6<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x WOF; subcut
  - (4) 6<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares, then cut each in half diagonally once for corner setting triangles
- (5) 8½" x WOF; subcut
  - (20) 8½" squares

**Fabric E, cut:**

- (7\*) 3½" x WOF for border
- (12) 2½" x WOF; subcut
  - (60) 2½" x 4½" pieces
  - (60) 2½" squares

*\*Cut 1 additional WOF strip if planning to join border strips with diagonal seams.*

**Fabric F, cut:**

- (8) 2½" x WOF, for binding

**Fabric J, cut:**

- (12) 2½" x WOF; subcut
  - (60) 2½" x 4½" pieces
  - (60) 2½" squares

## INSTRUCTIONS

Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread. Press as directed after each seam.

### Star Block Construction

- 1** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabric A-C** and **G-I** 2½" squares. **Fig. 1**

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- 2** Arrange a marked **Fabric A** 2½" square right sides together on one end of a **Fabric J** 2½" x 4½" piece. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press corner out. Repeat on opposite end. Make a total of 20 Unit 1 (2½" x 4½" unfinished). **Fig. 2**


- 3** In the same manner, make 20 each Units 2-6 with fabrics indicated. **Fig. 3**




- 4** Arrange 4 Unit 1, 4 **Fabric J** 2½" squares, and 1 **Fabric A** 4½" square in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows, pressing towards the **Fabric J** and **A** squares. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 Block 1 (8½" x 8½" unfinished). **Fig. 4**

- 5** In the same manner, make 5 each Blocks 2-6 with units and fabrics indicated. **Fig. 5**



## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

- 6 Noting the **Quilt Layout** diagram (page XX), arrange the blocks and the **Fabric D**  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares,  $12\frac{5}{8}$ " side setting triangles, and  $6\frac{5}{8}$ " corner setting triangles into (12) diagonal rows (the first and last rows consist of only 1 corner setting triangle each).
- 7 Sew the blocks, squares, and triangles into rows, pressing towards **Fabric D**. Sew rows together and press all seams in one direction. Quilt center measures approximately  $57\frac{1}{8}$ " x  $68\frac{3}{8}$ " (unfinished).
- 8 Stitch **Fabric E**  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips together end to end into 1 long strip. Cut (2) side borders  $68\frac{3}{8}$ " long and (2) top/bottom borders  $63\frac{1}{8}$ " long.
- 9 Sew the **Fabric E** side borders to right and left sides of quilt center, matching ends and centers, and press towards the border. Repeat to add the remaining borders to top and bottom of quilt center to complete the quilt top.

## FINISHING

- 10 Sew together the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric F** binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 11 Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 12 Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- 13 Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
