#### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Tula Pink 50 wt. Aurifil 100% Cotton Thread
- 87" x 87" (2.21m x 2.21m) batting



#### **CUTTING**

#### WOF = Width of Fabric

#### Notes:

- For fussy-cut pieces, starch fabrics and let dry prior to cutting to reduce the possibility of stretching or distorting the bias-cut edges. Focus on the large animal motifs - background colors may vary depending on the start and end points of the yardage cut. Use a removeable fabric pencil or marker to mark all the needed fussy-cut pieces on the fabric before cutting. If the fabric moves while tracing, place a piece of fine grit sandpaper underneath the fabric to hold it secure.
- Label cut pieces with fabric letter identifier and keep cut pieces grouped by fabric for easier piecing.

#### Fabric A, cut:

(10) 4" x WOF; subcut (100) 4" squares

(8) 21/2" x WOF for inner borders

#### Fabric B, cut:

(8\*) 5½" x WOF for outer borders

\*Cut 1 additional WOF strip if planning to join strips with diagonal seams.

#### Fabric C. cut:

(9) 21/2" x WOF for binding

#### Fabric D, fussy cut:

(4) 8½" squares, centering each square over a wolf's head motif

#### Fabrics E – K, fussy cut from each:

(3) 81/2" squares, centering each square over your desired animal motif



#### Fabric L, cut:

(1) 3" x WOF; subcut

(12) 3" squares

(3) 2" x WOF; subcut

(6)  $2" \times 11\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangles

(6)  $2" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangles

**Tip:** for the most efficient use of fabric, cut 2 of each size from each WOF strip.

#### Fabrics M – W, cut from each:

(1) 3" x WOF; subcut

(8) 3" squares

(2) 2" x WOF; subcut

(4) 2" x 11½" rectangles

(4)  $2" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangles

**Tip:** for the most efficient use of fabric, cut 2 of each size from each WOF strip.

#### Fabrics X – Z and AA – AV, cut from each:

(1) 3½" x WOF; subcut

(4) 3½" squares

(2) 1½" x WOF; subcut

(2) 11/2" x 131/2" rectangles

(2) 1½" x 11½" rectangles



#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

**Note:** All seam allowances are ¼" and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press after each seam as shown by arrows in diagrams.

1 Referring to the Block Layout table at **right** and the **Quilt** Layout diagram on page 10 for fabric combinations, group the cut pieces for each block. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all 3", 3½", and 4" squares.

**Center:** (1) 8½" square

#### Inner ring, all matching:

(4) 3" squares

(2) 2" x 81/2" rectangles

(2) 2" x 11½" rectangles

#### Outer ring, all matching:

(4) 3½" squares,

(2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

(2) 1½" x 13½" rectangles

Outer corners: (4) 4" Fabric A squares

Noting the orientation of the drawn line, place one marked 3" square right sides together in the upper left corner of the 8½" square. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Noting seam orientations, join the remaining 3" squares to the remaining corners of the 8½" square (Fig. 1).

Noting the orientation of the drawn line, place one marked 3½" square right sides together in the upper left corner of the step 3 unit. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Noting seam orientations, join the remaining 3½" squares to the remaining corners of the unit (Fig. 3).













Join an 2" x 8½" rectangle to the left and right sides of the step 2 unit, making sure the fussy-cut square in the center is right-reading. Join an 2" x 11½" rectangle to the top, and another to the bottom of the unit (Fig. 2).





















Join a 1½" x 11½" rectangle to the left and right sides of the step 4 unit. Join a 1½" x 13½" rectangle to the top, and another to the bottom of the unit (Fig. 4).









6 Noting the orientation of the drawn line, place one marked Fabric A square right sides together in the upper left corner of the step 5 unit. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Noting seam orientations, join the remaining Fabric A squares to the remaining corners of the unit (Fig. 5). Make a total of 25 blocks 13" x 13" finished.

- 9 Join all the 2½" x WOF **Fabric A** inner border strips end to end. Press the seams open. Cut (2) inner side borders measuring 65½" long and (2) inner top/bottom borders measuring 69½" long. Matching ends and centers, join one side border to either side of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the border. Repeat to add one top/bottom border to the top, and the other to the bottom edge of the quilt center.
- 10 Join all the 5½" Fabric B border strips end to end. Press the seams open. Cut two outer side borders 69½" long and (2) outer top/bottom borders 79½" long. Matching ends and centers, sew one side border to either side of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the outer borders. Repeat to add one top/bottom border to the upper edge, and the other to the lower edge of the quilt center to complete the quilt top.

#### **QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY**

- Referring to the **Quilt Layout** diagram on page 10 for block placement and starting with Block 1 in the upper left corner, work from left to right to arrange the blocks in (5) rows of (5) blocks each. Sew the blocks in each row together along adjacent edges. Press all seam allowances in each row in the same direction, alternating directions from row to row so seams will nest.
- 8 Matching seam lines, join the rows together along adjacent edges. Press all seam allowances in the same direction.

#### **FINISHING**

- 11 Sew together the 2½" **Fabric C** binding strips end to end. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 12 Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top after quilting is completed.

- 13 Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- **14** Turn the binding to the back of the quilt and hand stitch in place.

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
